A Marine Corps. veteran, Chuck is a graduate of the University of New Hampshire with a BS in Community Development. He began his career in politics in 1992 with the UNH College Republicans.

Chuck was elected as Area Vice Chairman of the NH GOP in 1995, serving Merrimack and Belknap Counties and the City of Concord.

His work has spanned a variety of candidates and organizations and states. Including such clients and employment as: New Hampshire Republican State Committee, U.S. Congressman Bill Zeff, Zeff for Governor, Bob Dole for President, Dan Evans for Delegate (Virginia), Colorado Citizens for Right to Work (with volunteer work for Marilyn Musgrave for State Senate), Montana Right to Work, New England Citizens for Right to Work and Citizens for a Sound Economy (CSE).
